




International Exchange Agreement
Between



the Faculty of Fisheries and Marine Science, Halu Oleo University and
the Tropical Biosphere Research Center, University of the Ryukyus


The Faculty of Fisheries and Marine Science, Halu Oleo University, and the Tropical Biosphere Research Center, University of the Ryukyus consent to enter into a formal agreement, based on a foundation of mutual trust established by previous exchange programs, to promote further exchange of students, faculty, and staff in order to advance scientific research, education, and cultural understanding, and to contribute to the mutual benefit and development of the two institutes.

1. The two institutes shall promote the following exchange activities based on their respective academic and educational needs:
 - (1) Exchange of students
 - (2) Exchange of faculty and staff members
 - (3) Exchange of academic materials, publications, and information
 - (4) Joint hosting of seminars, conferences, and symposia
 - (5) Joint research
 - (6) Other academic exchanges
2. The implementation of each exchange based on this agreement shall be separately negotiated and determined by both institutes. Exchange activities shall be carried out within the scope of each institute's financial, material, and institutional limitations. With this understanding and the mutual agreement of both institutes, memoranda based on this agreement may be signed.
3. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institute, nor will either party impose any constraints upon the other in carrying out the agreement.
4. This agreement is subject to revision by mutual consent. It is also understood that either institute may terminate the agreement at any time, although such action shall only be taken after mutual consideration in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to either party.
5. This agreement shall be effective when the representatives of both institutes have signed the agreement and is valid for a term of five years. It may be renewed with the consent of both institutes through the exchange of letters confirming the renewal within six months prior to the end of the term, and will be effective for another five years. In the event that this international exchange agreement between the two institutes is superseded by a university-level exchange agreement between the two universities, this agreement shall be rendered null and void.
